### **Background:**

On March 25, 2015, the City of Mesquite (COM) and The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) entered into Agreement No. (NM068-15-015), to complete the work to build a new interchange on Interstate 15 (I-15) at Milepost 118, including an approach roadway, interchange ramps, and a bridge over I-15.



July 26, 2016

On May 19, 2016, the City of Mesquite (COM) and the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) entered into Amendment No. 1 to

Agreement (NM068-15-015) to set forth the department's and the city's cost participation and responsibilities to upgrade and rehabilitate existing drainage culverts crossing I-15 and identify the right-of-way ownership within the control access of the project.

The purpose of this amendment is to set forth NDOT's and the COM's cost participation and responsibilities related to testing. NDOT has directed the COM to perform Naturally Occurring Asbestos (NOA) testing of local materials used on the project. As a result of NDOT's direction to the COM to perform testing, the City's contractor was delayed and has incurred additional costs to complete testing requirements, and NDOT is willing to participate in such contractor costs resulting from the testing.
